Sometimes "ch" will make the "k" sound. Whenever "CH" is part of a blend -- chr or chl -- it has the K sound.

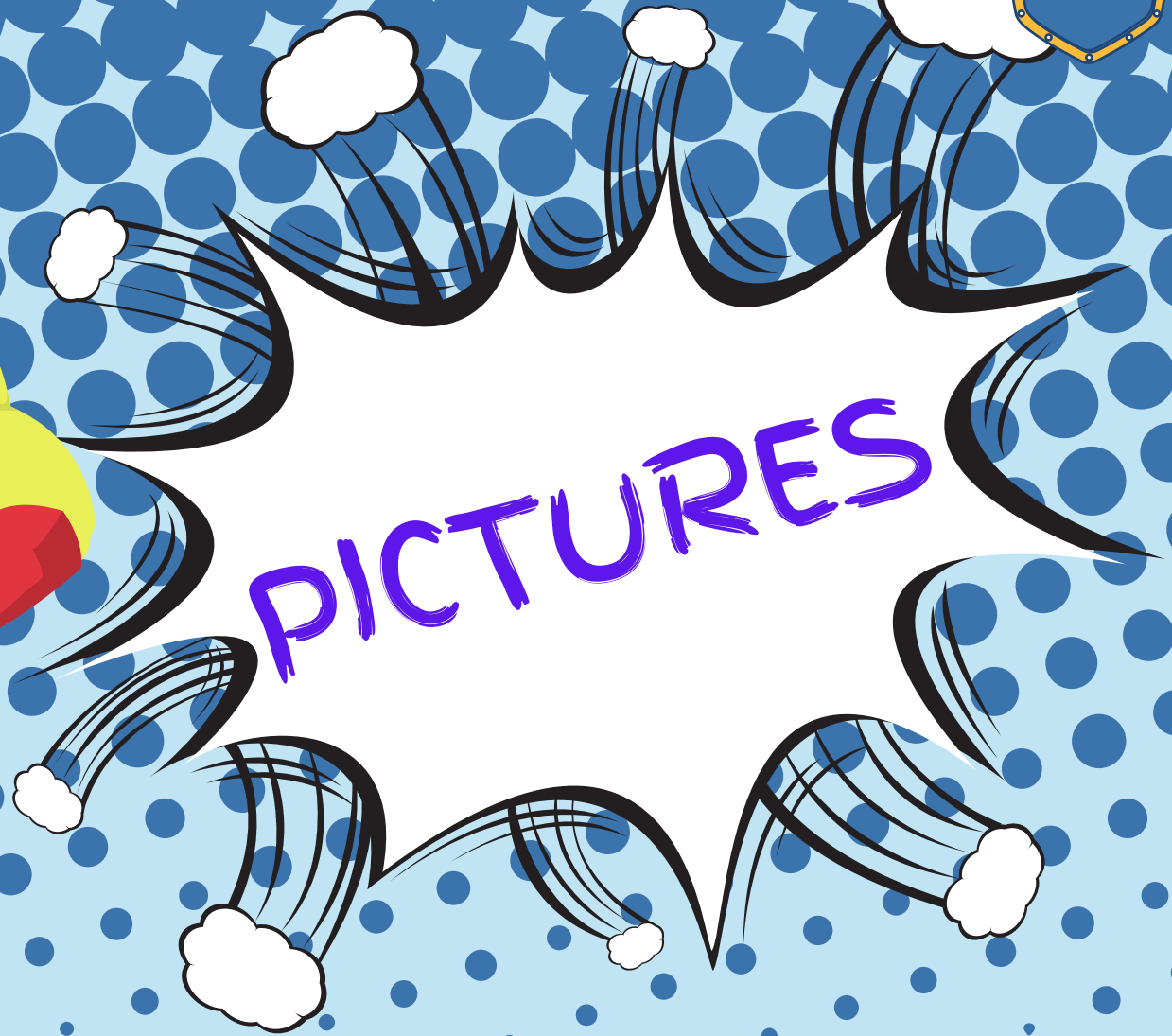

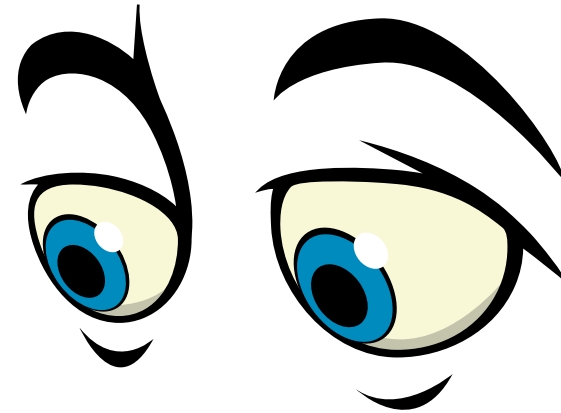

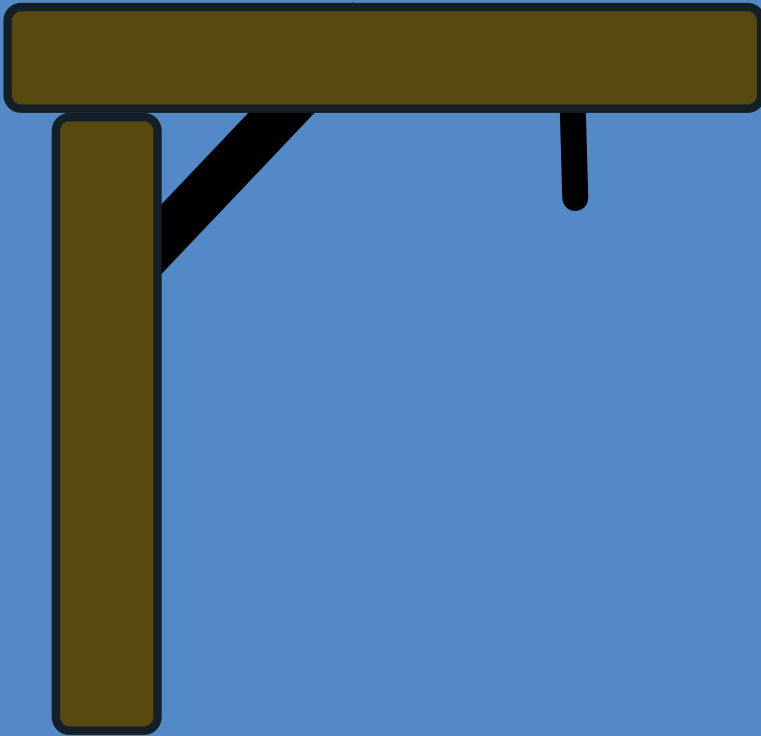
