

## ● Level 1 – Beginner (True Beginners)

✦ **Focus:** Basic vocabulary, phonics, and simple conversation skills

- ✓ Learn essential words (hello, colors, numbers, common objects)
- ✓ Answer simple questions (“What’s your name?” “How old are you?”)
- ✓ Recognize letters and begin learning letter sounds
- ✓ Follow basic instructions in English

✦ **Parent Expectations:** Your child will begin **understanding and using simple English words and phrases**, building confidence in communication.

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## ● Level 2 – Building Language Skills (Pre-A1)

✦ **Focus:** Expanding vocabulary, sentence building, and phonics

- ✓ Learn groups of words (nouns, verbs, and adjectives)
- ✓ Form simple sentences using **Present Simple and Present Continuous tense**
- ✓ Strengthen reading with phonics patterns (“ap,” “ot,” “cl,” etc.)
- ✓ Read and understand short stories

✦ **Parent Expectations:** Your child will start **forming sentences, recognizing more words, and improving pronunciation and confidence in speaking.**

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## ● Level 3 – Expanding Grammar & Fluency (A1)

✦ **Focus:** Advanced sentence structures, prepositions, and past/future tense

- ✓ Understand and use **Past Continuous and Future (“will”)**
- ✓ Read and comprehend longer stories with phonics and rhyming patterns
- ✓ Expand vocabulary and use **prepositions** in sentences
- ✓ Begin learning **Past Simple tense**

✦ **Parent Expectations:** Your child will **speak in longer sentences, ask and answer more complex questions, and start reading short passages independently.**

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## ● Level 4 – Transition to Intermediate (A1-A2)

✦ **Focus:** Stronger vocabulary, reading comprehension, and grammar refinement

- ✓ Learn words through **written definitions** (not just pictures)
- ✓ Read and discuss short articles and stories
- ✓ Strengthen grammar with **advanced phonics and spelling concepts**
- ✓ Speak with greater fluency using practice dialogues

✦ **Parent Expectations:** Your child will **begin using English more naturally in conversations and develop stronger reading and comprehension skills.**

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## ● Level 5 – High-Intermediate (A2-B1)

✦ **Focus:** Critical thinking, longer reading passages, and structured writing

- ✓ Expand vocabulary with **higher-level words and phrases**
- ✓ Read and understand longer texts and articles
- ✓ Express opinions and engage in structured discussions
- ✓ Master more advanced grammar concepts

✦ **Parent Expectations:** Your child will **read more fluently, discuss ideas in English, and build stronger communication skills in preparation for advanced learning.**

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## ● Level 6 – Advanced Learning (B1-B2)

✦ **Focus:** Strong comprehension, analytical thinking, and real-world communication

- ✓ Read **complex texts** and answer comprehension questions
- ✓ Learn to **infer word meanings through context**
- ✓ Speak fluently and confidently in conversations and presentations
- ✓ Master advanced grammar and writing skills

✦ **Parent Expectations:** Your child will **gain independence in reading, writing, and speaking, preparing for near-fluent proficiency.**

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## ● Level 7 – Mastering English (B2-C1)

✦ **Focus:** Fluency, idioms, critical thinking, and cultural awareness

- ✓ Understand and use **idioms and natural expressions**
- ✓ Read and analyze **complex texts, articles, and discussions**
- ✓ Express thoughts with **confidence, clarity, and cultural awareness**
- ✓ Prepare for **academic and professional English use**

✦ **Parent Expectations:** Your child will be **near fluent in English, able to hold deep conversations, debate topics, and read complex materials independently.**
